M G/ MB W	February 2018	<p>Update 04/08/18:</p> <p>Marielena spoke with Nicola Brunning to understand the current provision of the service and agree a way forward.</p> <p>West Suffolk hospital finished the procurement, the contract went to a company called Mediquip. They then sub-contract to Bartrums for the wheelchair contract, however from 30<sup>th</sup> Sept they will be handing over to another company called Rothcare (starting 1<sup>st</sup> Oct) who they feel will provide a more comprehensive service.</p> <p>Since this change the service specification has been improved; NHS England has said all children must receive a wheelchair within 18 weeks of referral, so within the new specification Rothcare will be asked to do the same for adults. We will be working with Rothcare and west Suffolk hospital to make sure that this can be achieved.</p> <p>There is going to be a presentation about this service at the next contract meeting on 12<sup>th</sup> July which I have asked to attend, the hospital will explain how the procurement will work in moving from one provider to another.</p> <p>After this meeting Nicola and I will meet to make sure the concerns of the service users are heard and ensure that people are involved with the monitoring of the service – this will be raised in the meeting. We will also raise the concern that a change in provider could cause some disruption, so we'll a need to agree a way forward to minimise these risks.</p>	Ongoing
