An individualised, complete person-centred assessment takes place and **local area emergency protocol** activated.




Mental Health Act process is followed.

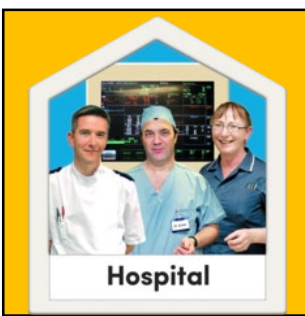
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The individual and their families and carers (where appropriate) understand the reason for admission and are supported to remain involved in planning, delivering and evaluating care.



Care and Treatment Reviews ensure that inpatient admission is the right option.



Evidence of the application of **MCA** (including **Best interests** and **DoLS**) followed and documented for admission.



Physical health checks and screening take place.



12 point discharge planning starts: development and review of a clear plan including: **projected timescales**, **assessment and treatment outcomes** and likely **duration**.



Health Action Plan and **Hospital Passport** updated.



Proactive **engagement** and **communication** with the individual and their families/carers

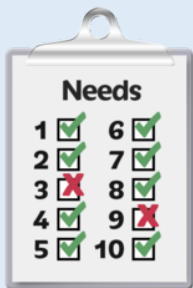
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Inpatient Team work with commissioners, social care and community services from day 1 to begin planning **discharge**.



Delivery of positive and **proactive care** within a **positive behavioural support framework**.



Development and delivery of **multi-element treatment plan** which reduce risks and address the person's identified needs.



Medication plan updated.



Relapse prevention and **crisis contingency plans** in place.

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A full suite of assessments and support plans that can transfer into the community are developed.



Post discharge plan developed with **Learning Disability and Autism Complex Care Team**.



Identification of a discharge facilitator to work closely with the community based **Care programme approach**.




Inpatient Team provide support and advice to those supporting the person in the community.

To continue to support them in relation to those areas of need that do not require hospital **intervention**.
