Contact made to Intensive Support Team due to Crisis by phone.

Significant transition Point e.g. discharge from inpatient setting .

▶ Go to page 4



Intensive Support Team triage referral immediately (trusted assessment).



Intensive Support Team visit patient in people's own homes, family homes, short break services, residential placements, short-term accommodation within 4 hours.



Rapid risk assessment takes place.




Immediate support provided.



Intensive Behaviour Assessment undertaken.

Go to page 3 for next step



Immediate modifications to the person's care and support take place (with the aim of reducing the risk of harm / placement breakdown).







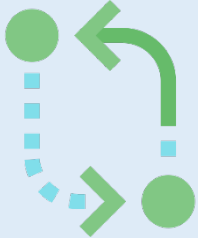
