- Prescribing Reinvestment to Practices of £1.2million 2016/17
- Successful international GP funding bid and GP retention programme; support for locum chambers and nurse training. Continuation of TED.

# High quality of care



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- Good performance against Constitutional Standards (18 weeks referral to treatment; A&E four hour targets and cancer diagnosis and treatment standards)
- Diabetes care management and stroke care standards for patients being amongst the best in the country
- A reduction in delayed transfers of care to 3.5% by end of March 2017
- Increase in Transforming Care patients living in their own homes
- Clearance of the backlog of patients waiting for Continuing Health Care Reviews



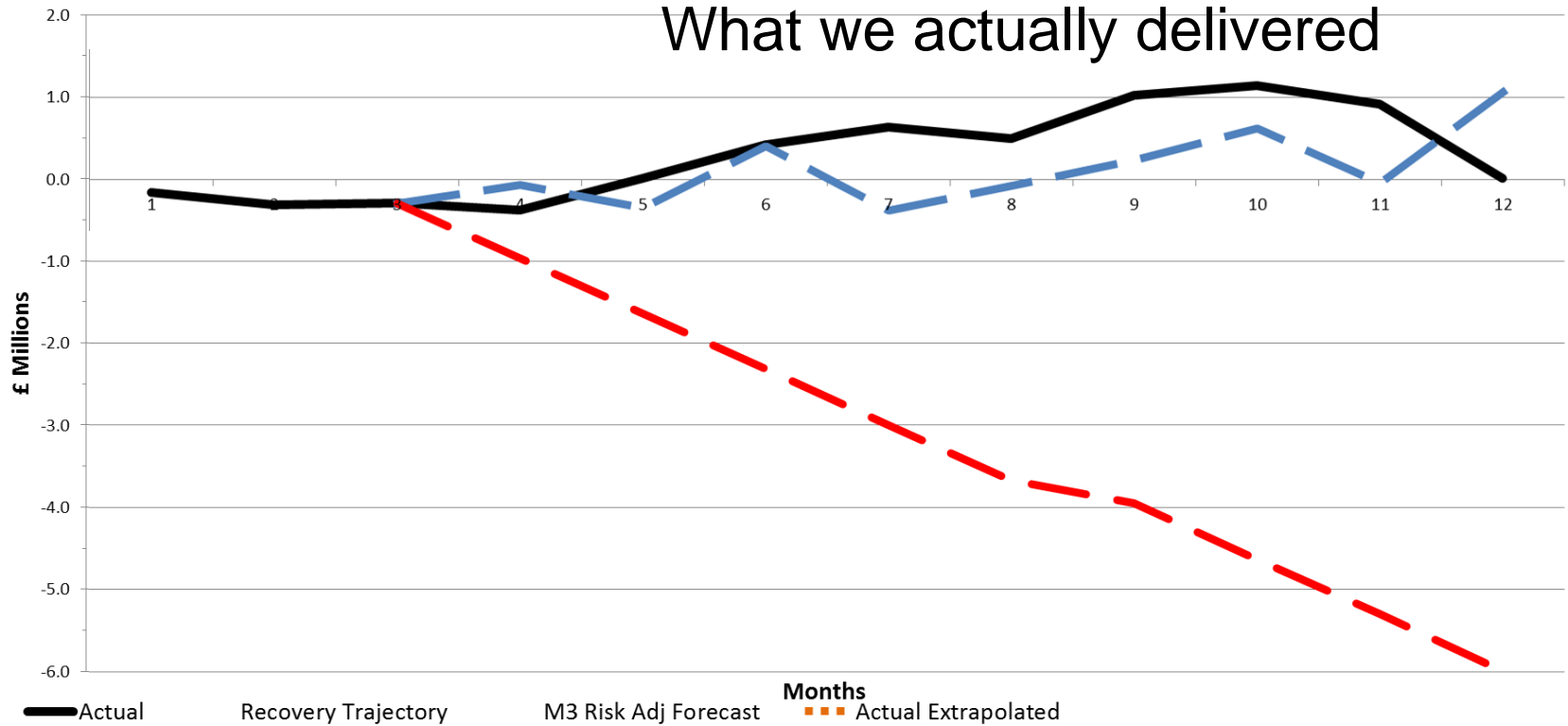
