

# PMS Development Framework

- The CCG has been working with colleagues at the LMC “PMS Negotiating Committee” to review the PMS Development Framework for next year.
- The following 9 indicators have been retired:
  - 2.1 Smoking Prevalence
  - 2.5 Breast Feeding
  - 2.7 Obesity
  - 4.1 ALL Referrals
  - 4.3 IT Initiatives
  - 6.1 Clinical Performance
  - 6.2 Health records
  - 6.3 Winter planning arrangement
  - 6.4 Disaster planning
- Only 1 new indicator in Meds Man for Diabetes and Frailty



## A summary of the 17/18 enhanced services:-

- No reduction in contract value for any service;
- NOAC will cease from April 2017. This investment will be transferred to a new polypharmacy LES to be developed in Q1
- High Intensity Care Home will be incorporated into the Care Home LES from April 2017
- Care Homes and 24 Hour ECG will be rolled forward for 3 months only whilst work continues to review how these can be commissioned at scale
- All other LES contracts have received only minor changes
