

PCSE WEBINAR 19th MAY 2021

As part of PCSE's preparation for the launch of the new GP payments and pensions service on PCSE Online, they are holding a webinar focused on GP practices to give practices some advance views of what they can do with the new systems.

This introductory webinar is being held between **11am-12.30pm on Wednesday 19 May**.

The aim is to give a selected audience of Practice Managers and Finance Managers an overview of the upcoming GPPP service. PCSE will be using their test environment to do this so dummy data will be used to show the various elements. The full data set can't be transferred in until the weekend before go live, but the webinar will give everyone a feel for how it works. PCSE will also be answering questions on the webinar.

PCSE are looking for **up to 10 practice managers or finance managers from the East of England** to join PCSE on this webinar. It is being held via Microsoft Teams. The number of attendees is being limited as PCSE want it to be open to Questions in a manageable way and also want to bring in people from across all regions. PCSE will be recording the webinar so that they can then make each section available to all Practices in the run up to Go Live.

The webinar will cover the following areas:

- Getting access – user registration and roles
- Statements - how to access your practice statement and the detail you'll be able to see
- Making claims – what you can claim for and how
- Joiners and Leavers – managing pensions deductions for Performers at your practice
- Pension estimates – managing and submitting Estimates of Pensionable Profits/Pay
- Approving Locum A forms – quickly review and approve pensionable locum work
