A new EOL website - www.tolivewithdying.co.uk - has been launched to provide residents in east Suffolk with information and support around subjects related to death and dying.

It is intended to act as a guide to local and national resources that cover issues such as how to talk about death and dying, living well with a life-limiting illness, planning for the future, terms used about death and dying, carers support, how to deal with an emergency, what to do when someone dies, bereavement, loneliness and support.

We believe professionals will find it a useful, accessible and easy to follow resource to signpost patients to on what can be a very difficult topic.
