

## DXS Update

### Latest updates to the DXS Professional section:

There has been a change to the DXS Tree making it easier to differentiate between local and national content. Suffolk CCG content is now housed in blue folders and national remains in yellow.

### Functional changes to forms:

DXS have introduced new functionality that can be applied to certain fields. This includes mandatory fields (appear pink), validation fields (yellow) and non-editable fields (white). Examples include

**West DEXA Scan** (SUF1098). This form must be initiated by a clinician and the referrer Name field will populate from the connected clinical system (logged on user). The form can be assigned for completion but the referrer name cannot be changed. The change has been made to comply with the Ionising Radiation (Medical Exposure) Regulations.

**West Lipid Service Referral** (SUF1776) now has three mandatory fields. This is a data quality initiative to improve the information provided to the clinic. This should prevent practices being called to provide the missing information after the referral has been received at West Suffolk Hospital.

**Emotional Wellbeing Hub** for CYP (SUF1391). This form is for patients aged under 25 years. Any date entered into the DOB field with an age over 25 will cause the field to turn yellow and display an error message at the bottom of the screen as a prompt to use the appropriate form.
