

Sensory Impairment Awareness training

The CCG have organised some online Sensory Impairment Awareness training sessions, which is open to care navigators, social prescribing link workers and PCN vaccination site staff, which will look at both hearing loss and sight loss.

The 1hr training session will be provided online by Sensing Change.

Hearing loss presentation

1. Learner will be able to explain the categories of 'Hearing Loss'.
2. Learner will have an understanding on the best way to communicate with a person who has a hearing loss.
3. Learner will be aware of the different types of technology to support a deaf person.

Sight loss presentation

1. Learner will have a basic understanding of the types of common sight conditions.
2. Learner will have an understanding on the best way to communicate with a person who has a sight loss
3. Learner will have an awareness of how to sight guide a person with a sight loss.

Each presentation will be around 25 mins with any questions at the end.
