REACT comprises nurses, occupational therapists, physiotherapists, healthcare assistants, generic workers, British Red Cross and Family Carers support workers.

Hours: 24/7

Urgent assessment can be arranged within 2 hours

Integrated Neighbourhood Team (INT)

The Integrated Neighbourhood Team (INT) is a multi-agency team, committed to understanding the needs of local people ensuring that services are well co-ordinated around their needs. The INT will include a core range of generalist services from **community health, adult social care, primary care and mental health**. The INT offers:

- Initial Support – on receipt of referral, phone or face to face intro to patient and family
- Follow up support – increased frequency of contact as per patient/family needs.
- Equipment provision – same day or 4 hour delivery available if needed
- Symptom control and management
- Fast Track assessment
- Onward referral to CHC, Hospice, Marie Curie, REACT (OOHs care)
