The ten point action plan for general practice nursing aims to:

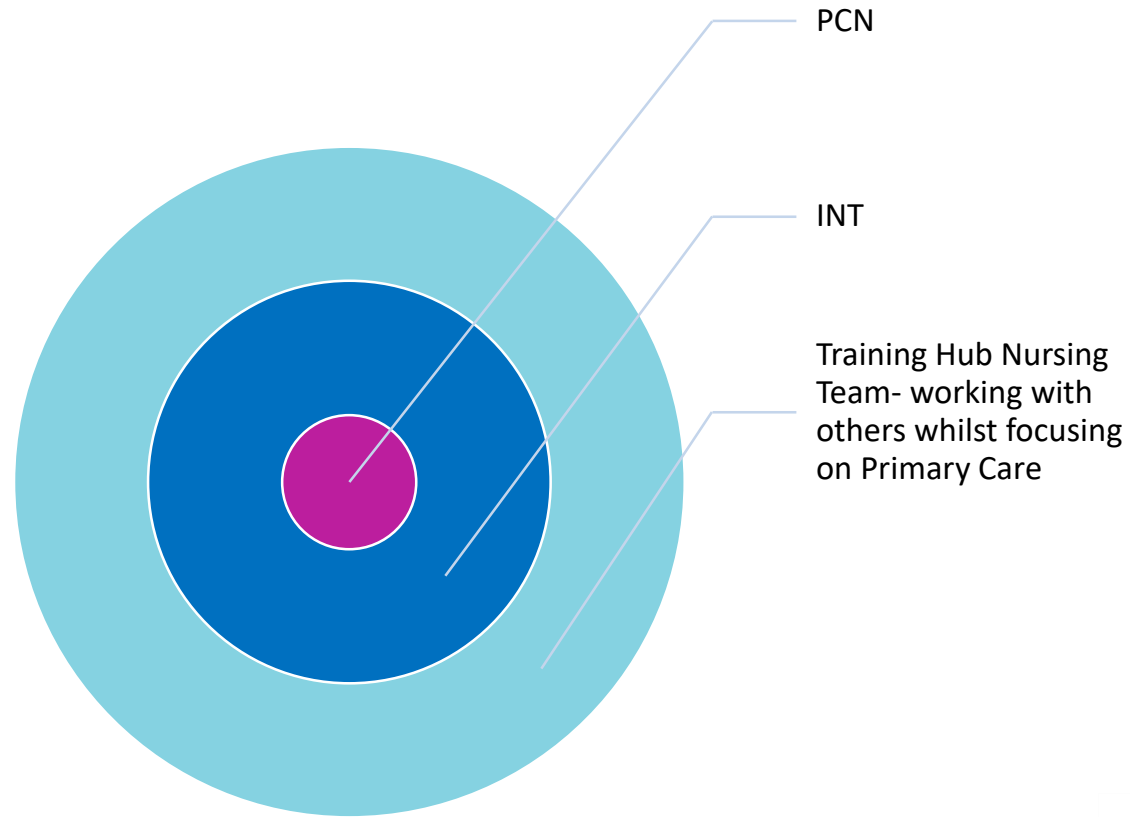
- Raise the profile of general practice nursing as a first destination career and develop induction and preceptorship programmes

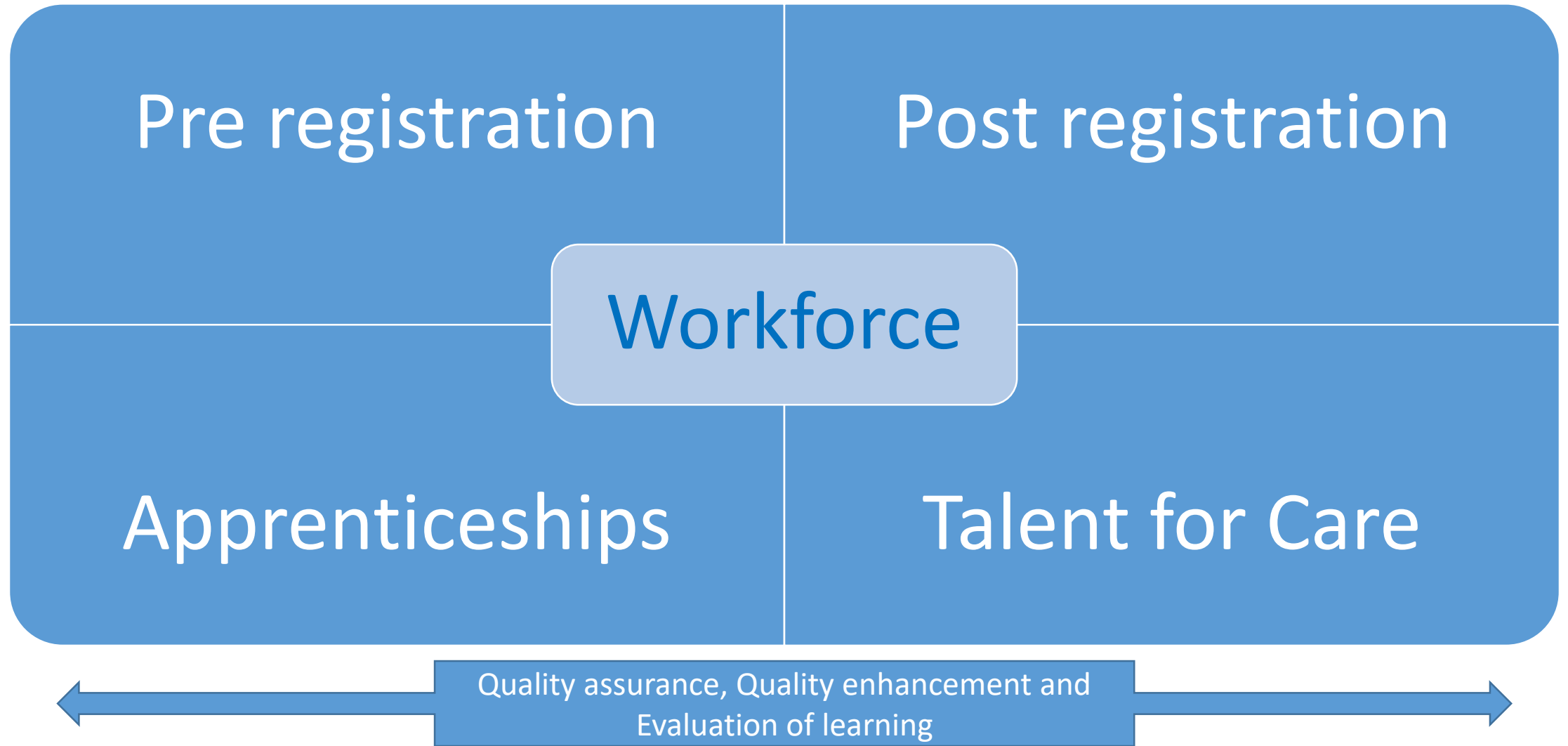
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Nursing work streams

- Health and Social Care level 2 and 3 (HCA)

- 20% learning time
- Level 2 maths & English
- 30 hour contract
